<u>Course Familiarization and Warm-Ups</u> Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of the class as directed by the judge to plan their strategy. Judges briefing will outline the course and answer handler questions. A warm up jump will be provided for each ring.

<u>Ringside</u> Exhibitors are responsible for being at ringside when it is their turn to run. Gate Stewards are only following directions to keep the trial moving smoothly for all. Please treat all volunteers working this trial for you with respect.

<u>Classes</u> STD, JWW, FAST & T2B Classes offered as described in Chapter 2, 10 and 11 in the Agility Regulations.

<u>Obstacles</u> Equipment conforms to the current edition of the AKC Regulations for agility trials CONTACT EQUIPMENT HAS RUBBERIZED SURFACES

<u>Food</u> Coffee and donuts will be available for breakfast as well as pizza, salad and water for lunch. There are also fast food restaurants nearby.

<u>Prizes and Awards</u> Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each Standard, JWW & FAST class and 1st place in each T2B jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to place. A personalized bar, rosette, donated by Michelle O'Brien, Evenstar Siberians, will be awarded to teams earning their MACH, PACH. All prizes must be claimed before the close of the trial except for the MACH or PACH awards which will be personalized and mailed.

<u>HIGHEST SCORING DOG IN AGILITY TRIAL</u> will also be receiving the following: The Kachme-Solocha-Yeti Agility Trophy. Offered by the Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc. through the generosity of members who value the great teamwork possible with our Siberian Huskies, at its National Specialty Show. The trophy will remain in the possession of the SHCA. Each year's winner will receive a photo taken with the trophy the day of the show, and their dog's name will be inscribed on the trophy base.

<u>Agility High in Trial</u> for each trial will be awarded from the STANDARD class, including Regular and Preferred to the Highest Scoring Siberian Husky. In case of a tie in score, then seconds under course time will be weighted as follows in determining HIT. Using the following calculation, High in Trial would go to the Siberian Husky with the highest number. Novice Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 1 Open Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2 Excellent/Master Preferred: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3. Novice: Seconds under course time multiplied by 2 with 5 points added Open: Seconds under course time multiplied by 3 with 5 points added Excellent/Master: Seconds under course time multiplied by 4 with 5 points added. The largest calculated SCT will be used when comparing dogs

jumping different heights who have competed against each other in a class at the same level of skill.

<u>Dogs Eligible to Enter</u> Siberian Husky only. dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

No more than 10 entries allowed per envelope. Express Mail entries (although not necessary) must waive "acceptance signature requirement". Entry form changes, corrections or cancellations must be done in writing before the July 27, 2022 closing date. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms. Entries must include the AKC agreement.

<u>Measuring and Height Card Information</u> When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List.

Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24"" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or

Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

<u>Height Divisions</u> Judges reserve the right to measure dogs without a valid height card. Dogs may not enter both Regular and Preferred classes for the same set of trials for the weekend.

Dogs that run in a division lower than their proper height will be eliminated. Preferred dogs must run at their measured height.

Notice to Exhibitors

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this, Exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Single copies of the latest edition of the rules may be downloaded without charge at www.akc.org or ordered from the AKC online through the AKC store.

Liability: The Club and the trial facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Park at your own risk.

<u>Collars</u> At the handler's option the dog may wear a FLAT or rolled leather collar but there shall be no attachments hanging or otherwise on collars. pinch collars, electric and dummy collars, are prohibited. Food, toys and whistles or other training devices are not allowed in the course area.

<u>Leashes</u> All dogs must be on leash (with the leash in owner's or handler's hand; not dragging on the ground) at all times except when in the designated Agility warm up area or when in the ring being judged. Flexi leads are not recommended in crating or course area.

<u>Refunds</u> No entry fee will be refunded if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Vet or judge or barred from the competition by act of the Trial Committee. No refunds are offered for sick or injured dogs or handlers.

<u>Withdrawals</u> For bitches that come into season after the closing date, the entry fee less \$10.00 per day administrative fee will be refunded if a letter from Veterinarian is received by 30 minutes before the first class in which the dog is entered.

<u>Move Ups</u> Dogs finishing the requirements for a title may move up to the next level of competition in accordance with AKC Agility rules. Day to day move ups will be allowed. CRATING SPACE AND EXERCISING DOGS AT SITE:

We will have plenty of crating space but only the designated and approved crating areas may be used.

Exhibitor's personal chairs will be allowed in crating area and ringside, but they must have caps on all legs. Chairs that can cause damage to the mats will not be allowed.

ASILES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.

Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his crating area and disposing of any waste.

DESIGNATED EXERCISE AREAS ARE LOCATED North of the All Dogs Can building across the parking lot. Dispose of waste properly in the outside receptacles that are provided.

ABSOLUTELY DO NOT allow dogs to urinate on the interior facility walls, posts, ring gates or trash cans or exterior walls or rocks adjacent to building. Dogs are not allowed behind the building.

<u>Parking</u> Parking is provided on a first come, first served basis at no charge. All vehicles will be parked at owner's own risk. Unlawful parked vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.

RV Parking is not allowed at the agility trial site.

Trial Site Rules

For purposes of this Trial, All Dogs Can and its surrounding are considered "Trial" grounds. As such, any damages or disrepair caused by exhibitors or their dogs to these properties will result in a Trial Committee Hearing and may result in disciplinary action

All Dogs Can is a non-smoking facility. Smoking is only permitted 50 feet or more from an entrance or doorway.

Chairs are not provided. Personal chairs are permitted. Waterproof tarps are required under your crate/chair.

ABSOLUTELY DO NOT allow dogs to urinate on interior facility walls, posts, ring gates or trash cans.

There is a \$5 fee for each and every potty accident.

This is a self-cleaning Trial. The Siberian Husky Club of America Inc. Is appreciative to have this facility and we ask your cooperation with cleaning up after yourselves and your dogs inside and outside of the Training Center. Although trash receptacles, clean-up equipment and plastic bags will be provided, it is the responsibility of each exhibitor to bring your own tools for clean-up after your dogs.

Dumping dog food in the restroom sinks or toilets is STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

Bitches in season and sick dogs are not allowed on the Trial grounds.

Dogs must be securely leashed or crated (contained) at all times, except when in Exhibit Rings.

Flexi-leads are not permitted in the Training Center.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower then their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No hox

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
